Mt. Fuji is the highest and most attractive mountain in Japan, but it is not an easy mountain to climb. but it's okay. Many people who have no mountaineering experience are also taking on the challenge. Since the altitude is over 3000m, you need to be more careful than low mountains such as high-level acclimation and low temperature, but please try to climb Mt. Fuji well by holding down the points.

■ Climbing season

- Subashiri / Gotemba / Fujinomiya route: July 10-September
- Yoshida route: July 1st-September 10th * Climbing outside this period is dangerous due to snowfall, etc.



■ Climbing entrance and climbing route

- Mt. Fuji has four climbing routes
- Routes are color-coded
- The trailhead is near the 5th station
- Be careful not to get lost at the Shimoyama road branch of Yoshida and Subashiri.



■ Climbing process

- The risk of injury and illness when climbing bullets is tripled.
- If you climb in a hurry, the probability of altitude sickness increases.
- Climb slowly, stay overnight and take a rest



■ Equipment required for mountaineering

- Complete measures against the cold
- Separate rain gear for mountaineering
- Don't forget the headlamps and water
- * Water can be purchased at mountain lodges, but there are routes that are not sold on the downhill road. Do not run out of water when climbing!



■ Access information • Private car regulations

- You can access the 5th station by bus
- * Car restrictions will be enforced on the road to the mountain climbing entrance during the mountain climbing period (excluding Gotemba exit).



■ Distress / accident risk information

- 5 hours for climbing and 3 hours for descending even on the shortest route
- There are many injuries due to falls when descending the mountain.
- Beware of altitude sickness! Let's climb slowly



■ About emergency rescue

- If you cannot move due to distress / injury, call 110/119.
- Mobile phones can be used during the mountain climbing season



■ Rules and manners for climbing Mt. Fuji

- Collecting animals, plants and lava, graffiti, setting up tents, and open defecation is prohibited because it is a sacred mountain.
- Do not litter the garbage and take it home!



■ Mt. Fuji weather

- The temperature difference between the mountain-top and the flatland is as high as 20 degrees!
- Equipment for cold weather measures and sudden changes in weather
- Be sure to check the weather information before starting mountain climbing.



■ Mountain lodge information

- If you are staying at a mountain lodge, make a reservation in advance.
- There is no hand-washing area or bath because water is precious.
- There are many places where cards cannot be used for payment.
